- * To bring interest in students towards entrepreneurship.

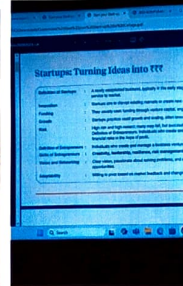

neership. Two trainers who were under their training

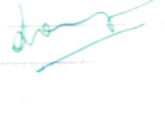
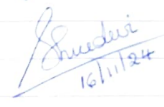
programme also shared their experiences.
