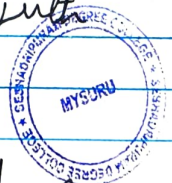
Objectives:- to inspire creativity and to enhance artistic skills.

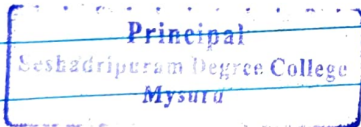

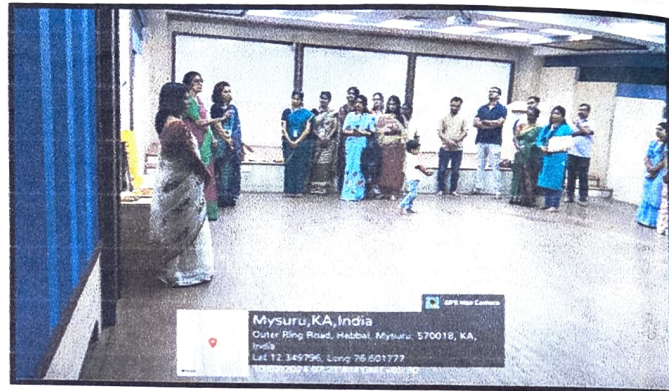

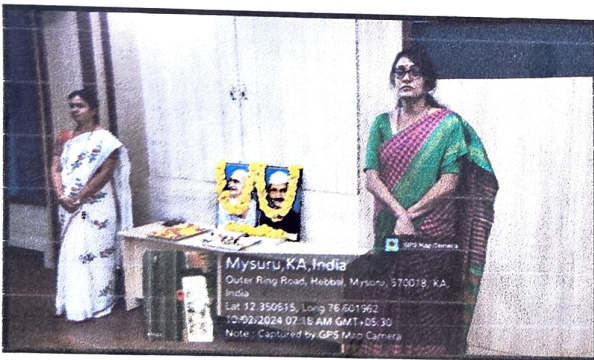

Report:- At the instance of IQAC, Seshadripuram Degree College, in association with Gandhi Study centre and Gandhi Study centre, Gandhi Bhawan, University of Mysore organised a special lecture on "Gandhi's Relevance to Today's Life" to mark 77th Sarvodaya Divas on 30 January 2025 at 10.30am in Gandhi auditorium, Gandhi Bhawan, Manasagangothri, Mysore.

The session began with the watering of a plant and a floral tribute to Gandhi's portrait by the chief-guest, Prof. S.R. Niranjan, vice president of the Karnataka State Higher Education Council, Bangalore, along with other dignitaries. Smt. M.K. Saritha, Registrar of the University of Mysore, Mysuru, led the gathering in taking the Sarva Dharma Samrakshana pledge.

Prof. S.R. Miranjan addressed the gathering, speaking about the education provided in universities across India. He also recalled the ancient Malanda & Takshashila universities. He reminded students that Gandhi's Struggle has allowed us to live in peace today. He emphasized the importance of technology & education for the growth of our country. He also reflected on Gandhi's dream of ensuring sufficient food for all, promoting women's education, & fostering India's development. Additionally, he highlighted the importance of the Skill India initiative, stressing that developing skills is essential for students to shape their personalities.



The resource person for the special lecture was Prof. H.J. Saraswathi, a Retd. Kannada professor from JSS Mahavidyalaya in Mysore. She began her lecture by reading a few lines about Gandhi written by Kumbhkar after his death. She posed the question, "Who is Gandhi?" and answered that he is one who upholds the words of the Mother, a doctor, a teacher, a philosopher, a Scientist, a farmer, a politician, a social reformer - he is everything.

She also spoke about Gandhi's early life in South-Africa & highlighted that many of Gandhi's friends were Christians, Muslims & parsis. She emphasized Gandhi's belief that all employment is equal & nothing is superior or inferior. She noted that while in jail, Gandhi spent his time keeping his surroundings clean & never discriminated.

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City remembers Mahatma Gandhi on Sarvodaya Day



Mysuru, Jan. 30 (BLU&DM). "Dr. B.R. Ambedkar had said that only those who have understood history can create history," said Karnataka State Higher Education Council Vice-Chairman Prof. S.R. Niranjana.

He was speaking after inaugurating the 77th Sarvodaya Day (Death Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi) in honour of Mahatma Gandhi, organised by Centre for Gandhian Studies, University of Mysore (UoM) in association with Seshadripuram Degree College at Gandhi Bhavan in Manasagangothri campus here this morning.

Stressing on the need for participating in such programmes in order to understand history, Prof. Niranjana opined that history can then only be created. Maintaining that the UoM has a rich history, he said that Nalanda University which existed in the ancient times, had as many as 10,000 students and 2,000 faculty members.

"It is because of the movements launched and the sacrifices made by great leaders

Rs.100 crore for organising programmes on Mahatma Gandhi throughout the year. Both the Government and private educational institutions should come forward for the construction of Gandhi Bhavans in their campus out of this fund. The Government is willing to sanction more funds if necessary for the conduct of programmes focusing on Mahatma Gandhi, he said adding that it is important to include the Mahatma's innumerable contributions to the society, in academics at all levels.

JBS Mahavidyalaya's former Kannada faculty Prof. H.J. Saraswathi delivered a special lecture on the topic "The relevance of Gandhi in today's life".

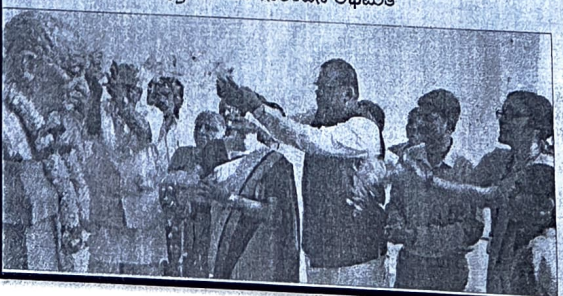

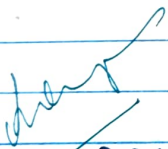
Report:- At the instance of IQAC, Seshadeipuram Degree College, Mysore in association with Gandhi Study Centre organised a field trip to Khadi Gramodhyoga Kendra, Badanavalu, Majangud Taluk, Mysore on 26th March 2025 at 10:00 am. Around 72 Students from I B.COM and I BBA took part in the field trip. The Khadi Gramodhyoga Kendra was established in 1927 by Mahatma Gandhi in Badanavalu, Majangud taluk.

Mr. Somashekhar, who oversees Khadi Gramodhyoga Kendra, shared how Khadi towels are made manually, starting from cotton and ending with Khadi fabric used for sarees, towels and handkerchiefs. He detailed

how cotton is spun into threads and woven by hand without any machines. Around 60 women are employed at the Kendra.

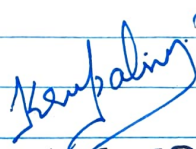

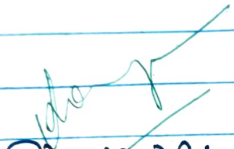

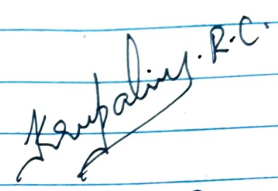
